## Gordon's Gin 37.5%

£1.95

Gordon's London Dry gin is carefully distilled using a secret recipe. The distinctively refreshing taste comes from the finest handpicked juniper berries and a selection of other botanicals.



## Beefeater Gin 40%

£2.40

Beefeater London Dry is one of the world's best selling gins, distilled in a traditional London Dry style. Using the finest botanicals, the time honoured method and the skill from the world's most experienced gin master distiller.



## Plymouth 42%

£3.00

It is different and slightly less dry than the much more common London style of gin, purportedly due to a higher than usual proportion of root ingredients, which bring a more 'earthy' feel to the gin as well as a softened juniper flavour.



## Tanqueray 43.1%

Made to a traditional London Dry Style in flavour profile and dryness. In a break with tradition, there are two separate distillations for the juniper and earthier botanicals that are later 'married' or blended with a second separate distillation of the citrus elements of bitter orange peel from Seville, lemon and lime peel.



## Larios Rose

£2.80

Spanish gin infused with strawberry. Soft and fresh citrus notes with aromas of succulent strawberry complete with a lovely long finish. The pink colour makes it even more appealing. Enjoy with a mixer of your choice and garnish with lime peel.



## Hendrick's Gin 41.4%

£3.35

A brand of gin produced by William Grant & Sons in Girvan, Scotland, and launched in 1999. In addition to the traditional juniper infusion, Hendrick's uses Bulgarian rose and cucumber to add flavour. Hendrick's gin is bottled in a dark brown apothecary-style bottle.



## Tanqueray No. TEN 43.1%

£3.50

The only gin made using whole citrus fruit, including white grapefruit, lime, and orange, along with juniper, coriander, and a hint of chamomile flowers, No. TEN has a unique, full-bodied character and citrus undertone.



## Martin Millers 40%

£3.00

This gin uses a mix of ultra traditional distilling methods allied to Martin's own iconoclastic 'take' on gin distilling. -In a break with tradition, there are two separate distillations for the juniper and earthier botanicals that are later 'married' or blended with a second separate distillation of the citrus elements of bitter orange peel from Seville, lemon and lime peel.



## Bombay Sapphire 40%

£2.20

Bombay Sapphire is uniquely different from other gins. This difference lies in the fragrances and flavours of its ten exotic botanicals coupled with a unique distillation process called Vapour Infusion. It's a blend of Mediterranean lemon peel, juniper berries, almonds and orris, balanced by a heady mix of coriander, liquorice, angelica and cassia bark and spiced with cubed berries and grains of paradise.
